Our post held the first ever homeless veteran stand down in Ocean County and assisted veterans and their families into permanent housing. As the stress of the lockdowns affected our brothers and sisters, we instituted twice monthly mental health sessions and doubled down on our suicide prevention efforts. We lent a hand up to veterans in need keeping food on their table and a roof over their head. Our mental health and suicide prevention program is second to none, and the Governor's veteran suicide prevention initiative is using our Post as an example of a successful program.

When the veterans' nursing homes and Veteran medical facilities open back up for visitors, please join us as we resume our holiday parties and bingo games for the residents.

Our Post Veteran Service Officer will be available at the Post in person or ZOOM at the Post on the first Wednesday of each month from 2 to 6 PM (always available by phone or email) to assist veterans in obtaining VA healthcare, educational or disability compensation benefits. The hand up --not a handout -- philosophy of Stand Down is carried out through the work of hundreds of volunteers.

The concept of Stand Down, as related specifically to the homeless veteran crisis, was the brainchild of two Vietnam Veterans, Robert Van Keuren and Dr. Jon Nachison, with the support of Vietnam Veterans of San Diego. The first Stand Down was held in San Diego during the summer of 1988.

Stand Downs are re-created to follow a regimented, militarystyle program, which is familiar and comforting to the veteran, while others create an atmosphere of empowerment to the extent of electing officers among the homeless veterans. All it really takes for a community to organize a Stand Down is a group of dedicated volunteers committed

New Jersey has traditionally held three Stand Downs a year in Newark, Cherry Hill, and Atlantic City, where hundreds of homeless veterans were bussed in and provided services.


Due to COVID restrictions the large Stand Downs were

cancelled and veteran advocates under the leadership on Bob Looby started conducting smaller and outdoor "Mobile Stand Downs". This concept has been successful bringing the services to the communities where veterans live.

We thank Bob and his team for choosing Ocean County and our Post as it's next stop and we look forward to serving our veterans.

Our Stand Down was open to homeless / at risk veterans. their families/significant others, and any veteran needing a hand up or services.

- 1. Ocean County has the largest veteran population in New Jersey with 35,360 veterans
- 2. The veteran resident population percentage for the Tuckerton-Little Egg Harbor area stands at 12.4 %.
- 3. On any given night, 551 of New Jersey's veterans are homeless.
- 4. The Veterans Transitional Housing Program (Veterans Haven North & South) are New Jersey Stateoperated facilities for homeless veterans. Eligible veterans must agree to a long term program focusing on psychological, social and vocational rehabilitation.
- 5. Veterans who are homeless or at imminent risk of homelessness are strongly encouraged to contact the National Call Center for Homeless Veterans at (877) 4AID-VET (877-424-3838) for assistance.
- 6. Local veterans and their families who need a hand up should contact our Post for assistance.
